

# Requirements

## **For interview:**

- Valid Driver's License/PA. Identification Card/Green Card/American Passport
  - Social Security Card
  - Valid Car Insurance
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- \$22.00 exact change or money order for Background Check (State price increase since December 1, 2017) (<https://epatch.state.pa.us/> )
- \$13.00 Child Abuse Clearance (<https://www.compass.state.pa.us/CWIS>) (New increase, now \$13.00)

### **OR**

- Non PA Residents or PA residents who have not resided within the state for the past 2 years, are required to submit the FBI criminal history background check processed by the PA Department of Aging.
  - (<https://uenroll.identogo.com/> ) fee \$25.75.
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- Direct Care Competency Test ([http://services.dpw.state.pa.us/pch\\_comptest/](http://services.dpw.state.pa.us/pch_comptest/))
- Valid PPD or Chest X-ray (if you do not have proof of either of the two, see 2nd page for nearby options)
